St. Lucy School Library Media Center Rules & Procedures and Behavior Expectations

LMC Rules & Procedures

- 1. FOOD and DRINKS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE LMC.
- 2. Be responsible and take good care of all your books.
- 3. Wash you hands before reading a library book.
- 4. Keep your library books away from food and drinks at home, school and in the car.
- 5. Treat books with respect. Do not write, cut, glue, or tear a book.
- 6. Never try to repair a damaged library book. Report any damage in the book to the librarian.
- 7. Handle books carefully and always keep them in a safe place such as your backpack.
- 8. Keep your library books out of the rain and away from babies and pets.
- 9. Use a bookmark for saving your place in a book. Never "dog ear" a page.
- 10. Never turn a book on its "face".
- 11. Checkout library books properly with the librarian.
- 12. Return your library books on time on your library day.
- 13. All books are due when the class visits the library.
- 14. Student book loan period is seven-days and books may be renewed for one-additional week.
- 15. You may borrow more than one book if you are working on an assignment.
- 16. Place your library book into your classroom Library Book Return Basket.
- 17. Do not remove any books from the classroom Library Book Return Basket.

LMC Behavior Expectations

- 1. Your respect and proper behavior are expected at all time. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated and you will be sent back to your teacher.
- 2. Obey all library and school rules.
- 3. Show respect, speak quietly and be considerate of others at all times.
- 4. Patiently wait your turn.
- 5. Listen and follow instructions the first time they are given.
- 6. <u>You are expected to check out a library book every week so you have a book to read at all time.</u>
- 7. Be trustworthy by returning your library book each week on your library day.
- 8. Being unprepared for your library visit will not be tolerated.

Your St. Lucy School Technology Use Agreement policies are to be followed.

- 1. Be picky when selecting online tools and websites.
- 2. Choose a screen name that doesn't reveal personal information.
- 3. Leave your public profile blank.
- 4. Do not provide personal information in postings or in response to messages.
- 5. Think twice before posting photos [warning: they *never* go away!]
- 6. Postings on the Internet are NOT private.
- 7. Once it's online, you can't take it back.
- 8. Remember that online "friends" are strangers.
- 9. When in doubt, talk with a trusted adult.

Additional Expectations

If you don't already have one – please get a Library Card from your local public library. Library Cards are free. You will need to use the public library for large projects and research assignments.

Set aside a regular time for reading at home, independent of schoolwork, the 20-minutes before lights out, just after dinner, or whatever time fits into your schedule. As little as 20-minutes of free reading a day can improve your learning and help you achieve academic success. Researchers, doctors, and educators recommend that you read for at least 20-minutes every day! And hey, the book might be so good you just won't be able to put it down! Make reading a priority in your life this year!
